There is new technology available with lasers in dentistry that does make going to the dentist a much more enjoyable process. Drill noise and vibration, anesthetic gels and the dreaded needle pinch all create anxiety and discomfort for patients. Laser technology eliminates all of those elements while also reducing trauma to teeth and gums.

What are some of the laser technologies in your practice?

We offer several laser treatment options. The Fontana LightWalker Erbium: YAG laser has created a huge change in treatment options. We chose this laser because of its high absorption and stable hardware history and support. The Erbium laser beam is concentrated light of a specific wavelength that is

absorbed in water molecules. Tooth enamel and dentin contain high levels of water in their structure. The laser energy photons interact with the water molecules and remove microscopic bits of tooth structure with virtually no pain or discomfort to most people. The laser creates a surface on a tooth that enables high levels of adhesion for the commonly used white filling materials.

Another laser treatment is the use of soft tissue lasers to improve treatment outcomes of surgery and Periodontic procedures. The LANAP protocol for Perio disease is a proven procedure that uses the properties of the ND:Yag soft tissue laser that kills 100 percent of the bacteria in the Perio pockets.

Through the use of hard tissue and soft tissue lasers, we are able to use Low Light Laser Therapy (LLLT) to put the body's tissue into the best state of healing possible after a procedure has been performed. We are now able to perform frenectomies, gingival recontouring, crown lengthening and cavity preps with very little to no pain, very little bleeding and no stitching, all through the use of our laser technologies.

Are you able to help people with issues like sleep apnea and snoring?

Yes, and we have specific laser protocol options that can help address those issues. Conventional treatments for snoring and sleep apnea have included everything from oral appliances to uvuloplastic operations, radiofrequency tissue ablation, CPAP masks and alternative medicine. Through our NightLase technology, we are able to offer a minimally evasive laser procedure that allows us to perform non-ablative tightening of the uvula, soft palate and surrounding tissues. The laser treatment causes a tightening of the oral mucosa tissue that is responsible for sleep apnea and snoring. This non-invasive treatment is gentle, but effective.

Are there other laser treatment options that you offer?

The FOTONA laser technology has enabled us to make available a number of cosmetic applications, such as LipLase and SmoothLase treatments. LipLase is a non-invasive procedure that will give fuller lips without injections or toxic foreign materials. The treatments boost collagen regeneration using laser energy. Results last between four and six months, comparable to injected fillers. SmoothLase treatments use your body's healing process, combined with focused laser energy, to transform the deep support layers under your skin to lift and firm loose skin around your mouth, lips and chin. It fills in and smoothens wrinkles. SmoothLase can also be used to treat under the eyes and perform minor neck lifts.


